Join us in March for two events. In celebration of the 100th Anniversary of International Women's Day, on Tuesday, March 8, at 7 p.m., at the **Garden Theater** in Frankfort, we'll be showing the acclaimed documentary film, ***A Powerful Noise***. The film focuses on three extraordinary women in Bosnia-Herzegovina, Mali and Vietnam as they lead day-to-day battles against ignorance, poverty, oppression and ethnic strife. There will also be a pre-show reception at the **Studio on Main** in Frankfort from 5:30 to 7 p.m., where there is a gallery show by three local women artists: Kristine Harvey, Amanda Acker, and Susan Wild Barnard. Admission to the movie is by donation, which will go towards the BAWHP scholarship or towards partner projects of CARE.

Our **29th Annual Education Day** is set for Saturday, March 26, at the **Trinity Lutheran Church** in Frankfort. Registration begins at 9:30 a.m., and we'll start at 10 with music by the **Song Spinners**. For the morning program, **Julie Guevara, Ph.D**, accreditation and assessment officer and professor of social work at Grand Valley State University, will speak on her 15-year project with a small community in El Salvador working with women and documenting the changes in their lives. After a lunch created by **Still Grinning Kitchens**, we'll enjoy interactive drumming with **Dede Alderman** and then we'll hear from women who traveled to Ethiopia in connection with the recent **Run Across Ethiopia** project seeking money for schools. Finally, **Susanne Glynn** will speak about her trip to Nepal in 2004 and the work of the non-profit group ANSWER. **Mary Anne Rivers** will close the day with song.

Fees pay for our program expenses, which we try to keep low. Your additional donation will help support our annual \$500 scholarship for a non-traditional female student at Northwestern Michigan College.
